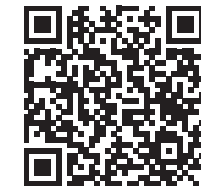

These diseases, transmitted by tiny arachnids known as ticks, include Lyme disease, anaplasmosis, babesiosis, and Powassan virus. Lyme disease, perhaps the most well-known, can cause fever, fatigue, and joint pain, with potential complications affecting the heart, joints, and nervous system. Anaplasmosis and babesiosis also present flu-like symptoms and can lead to serious health issues. Meanwhile, Powassan virus poses a rare but severe threat to neurological health.

A milder winter, such as the one we experienced in New York this year, has exacerbated the threat of tick-borne illnesses. Without harsh cold to curb their numbers, ticks have thrived, increasing the risk of human encounters and infections. This proliferation underscores the need for heightened vigilance and preventive measures among the public.

Protecting against tick-borne diseases requires proactive steps. Individuals should wear protective clothing, including long sleeves and pants, when venturing into tick-prone areas. Additionally, using insect repellents containing DEET or picaridin on exposed skin and clothing can deter ticks. Regular tick checks on oneself, children, and pets after outdoor activities are crucial for early detection and removal. Moreover, maintaining well-groomed lawns by mowing regularly and removing leaf litter and tall grass can reduce tick habitats.

Tick-borne illnesses represent a significant and increasing threat to public health, particularly in regions where milder winters allow tick populations to flourish. By understanding the risks and adopting preventive measures, you can mitigate the threat and enjoy outdoor activities safely.
